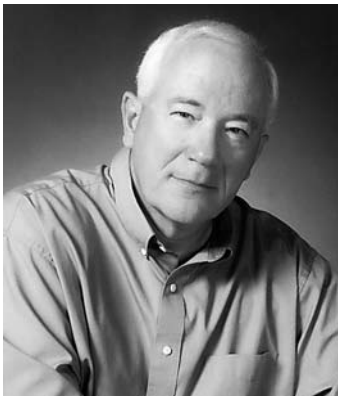

WHAT'S NEW IN THIS EDITION

In a continuing effort to improve each subsequent edition of *Hot R&B Songs*, some new features were added to this sixth edition.

NEW ARTIST RANKING METHODOLOGY

Due to the large number of “Featured” artists appearing on today’s recordings, our ranking method gives less points to an artist when shown as a “Featured” artist than as the lead artist. An artist receives 20% of the points for his “Featured” titles. For example, for the title “Get Up” by Ciara Featuring Chamillionaire, Ciara receives 100% of the points assigned to this title as she is the lead artist, while Chamillionaire receives only 20% of the points as he is the “featured” artist.

RE-ENTRIES

If a title was off the chart for more than 12 weeks and peaked in a different year, it is now considered a re-entry. All re-entries now appear immediately below the original chart entry for easy reference.

DUET TITLES

All duos, featured names and song titles by multiple artists are shown as they are listed on the record labels and sleeves. All regular duets, such as Marvin Gaye & Tammi Terrell, are now grouped below the solo titles at the end of the artist listing.

DIGITAL DOWNLOADS

In keeping up with the ever-changing musical landscape, a new special symbol marks all digital download-only hits.

* For decades *Billboard* compiled their R&B singles charts from playlists reported by radio stations and surveys of retail sales outlets. On December 5, 1992, *Billboard* dramatically revised the compilation methodology of the *Hot R&B Singles* chart and thus improved the chart's accuracy. Since then, *Billboard* has compiled the chart from a combination of input from radio stations continuously monitored by Broadcast Data Systems (see "Chart Methodologies" on page 10), additional playlists from small-market stations, and actual point-of-sale information provided by SoundScan, Inc.

** *Billboard* begins including airplay-only tracks on the R&B Singles chart.

Other core members: Eddie Hazel (guitar), Gary Shider (guitar), Michael Sterling (bass; <b>Sterling Silver</b> ) and Tiki Fulwood (drums). Known as "A Parliamentadelicament Thang," this funk corporation included various offshoots: <b>Bootsy's Rubber Band</b> , <b>The Horny Horns</b> , <b>The Brides Of Funkenstein</b> , <b>Parlet</b> and <b>Xavion</b> , among others. Concert tours featured elaborate staging and characters. In 1977, Haskins, Simon and Thomas split from Clinton; in 1981, they recorded as Funkadelic for LAX (and later as <b>Original P</b> ). The corporation disassembled in the early 1980s and Clinton recorded with some members as <b>P-Funk All Stars</b> ("P" stands for pure). Clinton signed his first solo recording contract in 1982.
