Born on 12/8/1947 in Nashville, Tennessee; raised in Daytona Beach, Florida. Died of liver cancer on 5/27/2017 (age 69). Southern-rock singer/organist. Brother of Duane Allman ; member of The Allman Brothers Band . Married six times, including Cher from 1975-79 (their son, Elijah Blue, fronts the group Deadly). Played "Gaines" in the 1991 movie <i>Rush</i> . His band included brothers Dan Toler (guitar) and David Toler (drums), Tim Hedging (keyboards), Chaz Trippy (percussion) and Bruce Waibel (bass; committed suicide on 9/2/2003, age 45). ALLMAN BROTHERS BAND, The						
Southern-rock band formed in Macon, Georgia. Original lineup: brothers Gregg Allman (vocals, organ) and Duane Allman (lead guitar), Dickey Betts (guitar; vocals), Berry Oakley (bass), Claude "Butch" Trucks (drums) and Jai Johnny Johanson (drums). Gregg and Duane first recorded together as the Allman Joys and Hour Glass . Duane Allman died in a motorcycle crash on 10/29/1971 (age 24). Oakley died in a motorcycle crash on 11/11/1972 (age 24); replaced by Lamar Williams (died on 1/21/1983, age 36). Chuck Leavell (keyboards) added in 1972. Group split up in 1976. Leavell, Williams and Johanson formed the fusion-rock band Sea Level . Allman, Betts and Trucks reunited in late 1978 with Dan Toler (guitar) and David Goldflies (bass). By early 1980, Dan's brother David Toler (drums) had joined. Group once again split up in 1982. Allman, Betts, Trucks and Johanson reunited in 1989 with Warren Haynes (guitar), Allen Woody (bass) and Johnny Neel (keyboards). Neel left in 1991; replaced by Mark Quinones . Haynes and Woody formed Gov't Mule . Woody died of a heart attack on 8/26/2000 (age 44). By 2003, Derek Trucks (guitar; nephew of Butch Trucks) had replaced Betts and Otiel Burbridge (bass) had joined. Butch Trucks died of a self-inflicted gunshot on 1/24/2017 (age 69). Gregg Allman died of liver cancer on 5/27/2017 (age 69). Betts died on 4/18/2024 (age 80).

Hard-rock band formed in England: **Robert Plant** (vocals; born on 8/20/1948), **Jimmy Page** (guitar; born on 1/9/1944), John Paul Jones (bass, keyboards; born John Baldwin on 1/3/1946) and John "Bonzo" Bonham (drums; born on 5/31/1948; died of asphyxiation on 9/25/1980, age 32). First known as the New Yardbirds. Page had been in **The Yardbirds** from 1966-68. Plant and Bonham had been in a group called Band Of Joy. Group formed own Swan Song label in 1974. In concert movie *The Song Remains The Same* in 1976. Group disbanded in December 1980. Plant and Page formed **The Honeydrippers** in 1984. Page also with **The Firm** (1984-86). Jones joined **Them Crooked Vultures**. "**Bonham**" is the name of group formed by Jason Bonham, John's son, in 1989. Led Zeppelin's most famous recording, "Stairway To Heaven" (on album *Led Zeppelin IV*), was never released as a commercial single.
